# A Tasting Race

Replace the standard cocktail reception with an international taste-testing teamwork race.

## Overview

This program is similar to our “Amazing Worldwide Race,” but teams solve clues to reach “countries” where everyone assembles and tries a food, dessert item, or beverage from that country. If your team has done the typical cocktail reception too many items, this may be the perfect mixer at the end of a long day of meetings. Build teamwork, develop relationships, and have a lot of fun all at the same time.

- ✓ Enjoy some great tasting food from around the world.



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## Agenda & Activities

**Welcome & Warm-Ups** (5-10 minutes) Atlanta Challenge staff welcome the participants and introduce the event. We then lead some fun activities to get everyone moving.

**Team Up** (5-10 minutes) Utilizing a few fun and interactive “games,” we randomly create small teams. Each team creates a name and cheer for their group.

**The Race** (1-2 hours) Teams solve clues that lead them to a series of “destinations,” where they will assemble and then taste a sample of each country’s food (appetizers, snacks and beverages are also options). To ensure that everyone stays active the entire time, the event is scored based on how many total points a team achieves before time runs out, rather than who finishes first.

**Destination Clues:** Teams solve clues to determine their destination country, then they take their “ticket” to the appropriate country food station.

**Country Food Challenges:** When teams “arrive” at their destination country, they will be given instructions on what food item they are assembling, and the ingredients they will need. They then put together a dish (or individual servings) of the food, and have it inspected before diving in with their forks.

**Travel Challenges:** As teams are “traveling”, or while waiting at a station, they can work on these bonus projects. This helps to keep everyone engaged, and also serves as a tie breaker.

**Team Bingo:** Instead of only talking to the people on their team, players will need to seek out people on other teams in this fun get-to-know-you game.

**World Food Trivia:** Teams demonstrate their worldly knowledge in this cuisine-based trivia challenge.

**Photo Shoot:** These are fun pictures that teams take of themselves, and sometimes with other teams, to help stretch their creativity and build camaraderie.

**Scoring** (15 minutes) Teams finalize their score sheets and complete their team debrief questions page. All team scores are announced from lowest to highest.

**Wrap-Up** (5-10 minutes) At the end of the program, the teams come together to share their experiences and the lessons they have learned.
