Overview

- ✓ Build morale and camaraderie through hilarious competition.



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Agenda & Activities

Welcome & Warm-Ups (5-10 minutes) Atlanta Challenge staff welcome the participants to a fun team building program and lead some fun icebreakers to get the group fully engaged.

Team Up! (5 minutes) Our last warm-up game will also randomly create small teams. Once in their teams, participants take a moment to get to know each other better.

Event Intro (5 minutes) The rules for the catapault team building are explained, and materials are distributed to the teams.

Design Phase (5-10 minutes) The teams examine their building materials and develop various ideas for what to build and how to build it. This is done as a separate phase so that conversations can take place later on about how the group shares, and hears, different ideas.

Building Phase (30-60 minutes) Teams build their catapaults with one eye on creativity and the other on quality. Their catapault will earn points for creativity and quality, as well as for how well it throws. This creates interesting insights into how the team makes decisions and executes their plans during teamwork projects.

PR & Test Range (10 minutes) Each team brings their catapault to the launching area to brag about their engineering and creative superiority. They will then have an opportunity to do a test round and make improvements to their teamwork projects before the main event.

The Duel (10 minutes) This is the “main event” of the catapault team building. Each team is paired up with another team, and attempts to fire as many birds as they can at the other team’s wall to knock down their pigs, while at the same time keep their own wall rebuilt while under fire. Final points are awarded based on the quality of their catapault, how much wall their team has standing, and how many pigs have survived.

Team Presentations (10-15 minutes) The teams come together at the end of the fun team building program to share their insights about what it takes to be creative AND effective, especially while under time pressure and facing stiff competition.
